


## Knowledge Organiser: Science

Plant	A living thing that stays in one place and makes its own food from sunlight.		
Roots	The part of a plant that grows underground.		
Stem	The part of a plant that grows above ground and keeps the plant upright.

Flower	The colourful part of a plant where seeds are made.	<input type="checkbox"/> An evergreen tree’s leaves stay on all year round, are tough, waxy, always green and are narrow and needle-like.	
Prediction	Trying to tell what is going to happen in the future.	<input type="checkbox"/> A deciduous tree’s leaves fall off during the Autumn season, change colour and are wide and flat.	
		<input type="checkbox"/> The basic structure includes; leaves, flowers, petals, fruit, roots, bulb, seed, trunk, branches and stem.	To measure and compare leaves around the school grounds.
